Term	Definition Components
Academic Content	
Degree Program	<p>Degree programs regularly have special/unique:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admissions • Content/curriculum • Diploma <p>50% difference in curriculum/courses between degree programs</p> <p>Impact on transcript:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Degree noted on transcript <p>Impact on diploma:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Degree noted on diploma
Concentration	<p>Curriculum/content must have at least 20% difference in curriculum/courses between other programs in these areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Courses, practicum, and/or research <p>Must have enough qualified faculty (according to professional accreditation standards) to teach/guide a concentration</p> <p>Must have appropriate clinical practice sites, if applicable</p> <p>Impact on transcript:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Concentration may be noted on transcript depending on program's needs <p>Impact on diploma:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Concentration may be noted on diploma depending on program's needs
Specialization	<p>Adds to the concentration</p> <p>Impact on transcript:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specialization <i>not</i> noted on transcript <p>Impact on diploma:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specialization <i>not</i>
